### Front and rear display

## Getting Started

---

### Connecting your power source

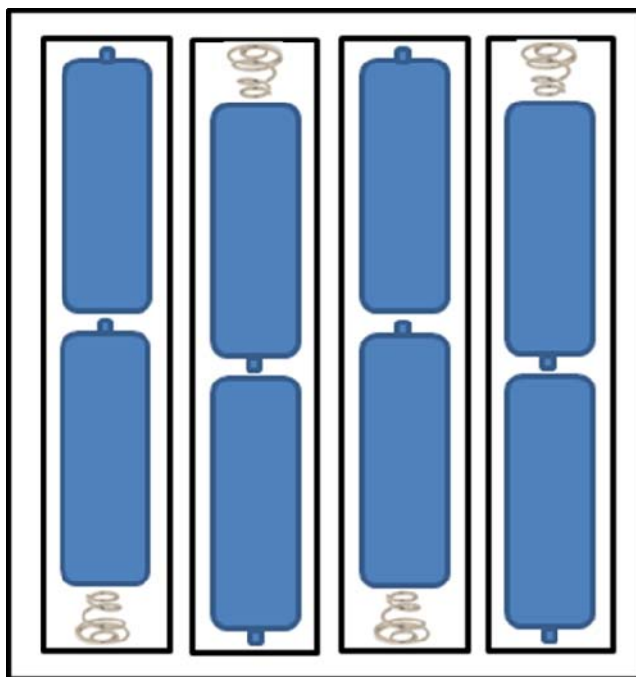
Before switching on make sure that the voltage of your electricity supply is the same as that indicated on the rating plate. Connecting to other power sources may damage the unit.

### AC Power Operation

Connect the AC Power Cord to your AC household mains outlet and switch on the mains supply. Make sure the voltage is compatible. Disconnect the power cord from the mains when not in use.

### Battery Operation

Open the Battery Compartment at the back of the unit and insert 8 LR14 size C batteries following the polarity diagram shown inside the battery compartment.

## Radio Operation

---

### Radio Operation

1. Set the Function Selector into the RADIO position.
2. Set the Band Selector to AM or FM position to select the band.
3. Tune to the desired radio station by turning the Tuning Control left or right.
4. Adjust the Volume Control to the desired level.
5. To turn off the radio, set the Function Selector to the OFF position.

### Antenna

For FM reception there is a built-in telescopic FM antenna at the rear of the unit. Extend the antenna and move it around to obtain the best reception.

For AM reception the signals are picked up through a built-in ferrite antenna. You may have to relocate the unit to obtain the best reception.

## CD OPERATION

---

### Playing Audio CDs

1. Set the Function Switch to the CD position.
2. Press the Function Button to select CD mode, the CD icon will appear on the LCD display.
3. Insert a CD disc into the CD compartment and close the CD door, the unit will start reading the disc, it will show the total number of tracks of the entire disc after reading.
4. Press the Play/Pause Button to start playing the disc.
5. During play back, press the Play/Pause Button to temporarily pause playing. To resume, press the Play/Pause button again. Press the skip up or skip down to change the current track.
6. Note: This player only plays original music CD's it will not play MP3 or WMA file CD's.

## PLAY MODE SELECTION

### Skipping tracks

During play or pause mode, press the Next Button to go to the next track.

During play or pause mode, press the Back Button to go back to the beginning of the track. Press the Skip Back Button again will go back to the previous track. To fast forward press and hold the Next button or to rewind press and hold Back.

### Repeat mode

Press the Repeat Button to select different kinds of play mode with the following sequence.

Repeat ➔ Repeat All

## STORING YOUR SONGS FOR PLAYBACK

The programming can only be done in the Stop mode

1. Press the Program Button, the LCD display will display **0** and flash.
2. Use the Skip Next or Skip Previous Button to select the desired track.
3. Press the Program Button again to store the selected track into the memory, the LCD display will display **0** again and flash continuously.
4. Repeat steps 2 to 3 to store more tracks into the memory. You can store up to 20 tracks in the memory at any one time.
5. Press the Play/Pause Button to start playing the disc in the programmed order.
6. To stop playing, press the Stop Button.
7. To cancel the programming list, press the Stop Button and open the CD compartment door or select a different function.

## AUX IN CONNECTION

### AUX IN JACK

In order to use the AUX connection simply plug a aux wire into your MP3 player and the other end into the AUX IN on the boombox. When you start to play your MP3 player the boombox will automatically start to play your stored songs.
