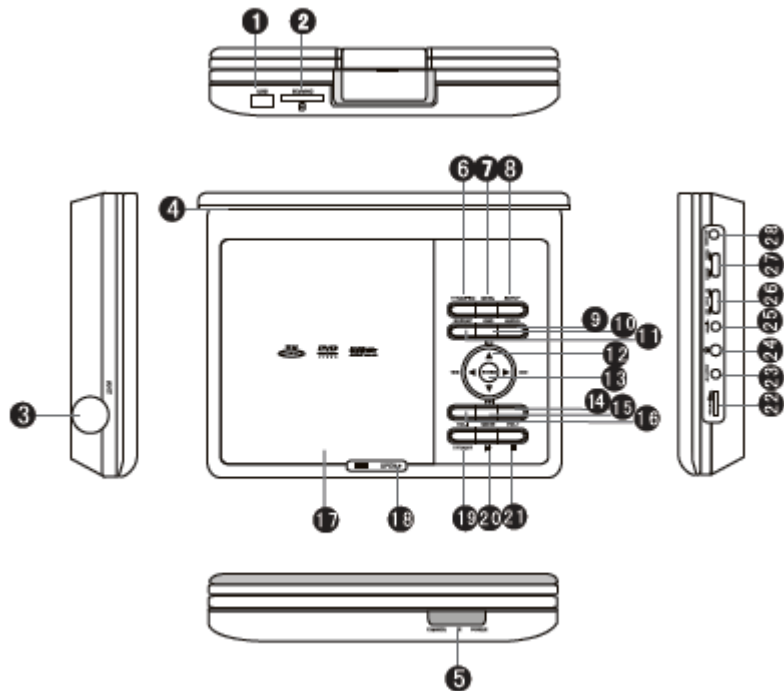

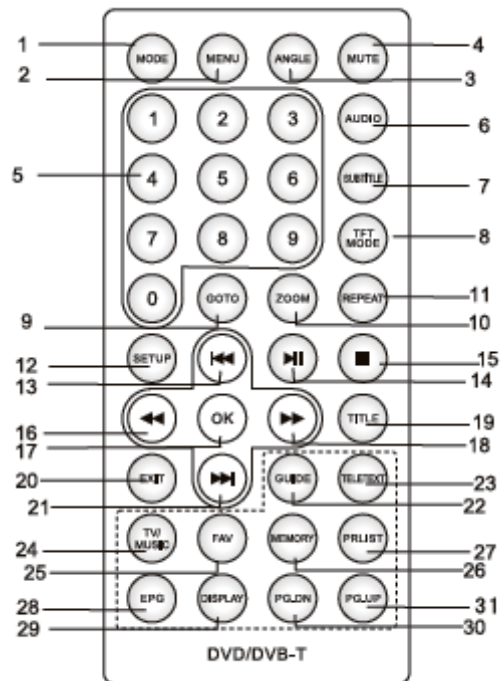

DVD Setup and Menu Options

Playing a DVD

In order to play a DVD first open up the DVD lid by sliding the open switch to the right. Remove the safety card inside before placing a DVD into the player. Now close the lid and insert the 12v mains adaptor supplied with the unit and switch the charge/power button on the side of the unit to "power".

Note: If you wish to charge the player first and not run of the mains then leave the plug in and switch to "charge" located on the side of the player, leave in this position for at least 6 hours to give it a full charge.

Once you have switched the player on you will need to first make sure your in the DVD mode. To do this press the "mode" button and then using the arrow keys move to "DVD" and press "ok". The DVD will now load automatically and the main menu will be displayed, use the arrow keys to move through the options of the selected DVD and press "ok" to confirm the selection.

You can playback a disc at 2x, 4x, 8x, 16x or 32x the normal speed for fast forward or rewind.



Press the REV or FWD button during playback.

The playback speed changes, each time you press the REV or FW D button (as shown above).

You can locate a specific title using the title menu function, if a DVD video disc contains a title menu.

1. Press the TITLE button

The title menu will be displayed

2. Press the cursor keys to select the title you want.

You can also directly locate a specific title by pressing its assigned number with the numerical keys (this may only function on certain discs)

3. Press the ENTER button

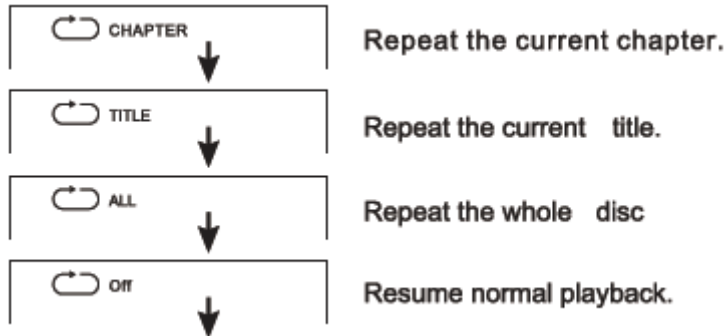
This will cause the DVD video layer to start playback from chapter 1 of the title selected.

Note: This function only works on DVD's with title menu encoded into it

DVD Setup and Menu Options

Repeat function

During normal playback, press the REPEAT button. The repeat mode changes, each time you press the REPEAT button (as shown below).





This DVD video player allows you to zoom into a picture as well as the zoom point.

Zoom

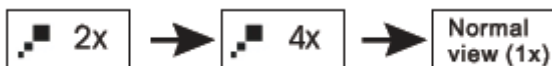
Press ZOOM during normal playback or slow-motion.

The player magnifies in the center of the picture.

Press     .keys during zoom mode to pan



Press the ZOOM button repeatedly to cycle through the available magnification levels (as shown below).

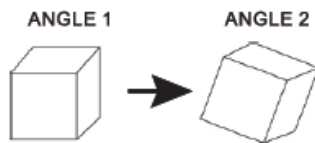

Subtitles

While playing a DVD you can switch off/on the subtitles by pressing the subtitle button on the remote. Note that not all DVD's have subtitles encoded into them.

Camera Angle

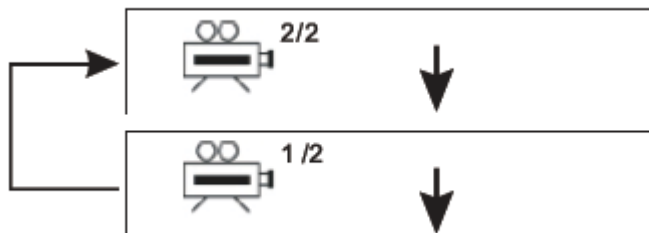


Selecting the camera angle

If the DVD video disc was recorded with multiple angles, you have the option to change the camera angle for the scene you are watching.

Press the ANGLE button repeatedly during playback of a scene recorded with multiple angles (when available).

- You may only press the ANGLE button when the angle icon  is flashing on the DVD display.
- Each time you press the ANGLE button, the angle will change.



- The angle function will not work on DVD video discs that do not contain scenes recorded with multiple angles.

Language Menu

Select the menu option by pressing the ok button, then enter into the submenu to preset the default Menu Language. If the DVD film does not support that language then it will not be used.

Audio

Select the menu option by pressing the ok button, then enter into the submenu to preset the default Menu Language. If the DVD film does not support that language then it will not be used.



Subtitle

Select the menu option by pressing the ok button, then enter into the submenu to preset the default subtitle Menu Language. If the DVD film does not support that language then it will not be used.

External Subtitle

Select the menu option by pressing the ok button, then enter into the submenu to preset the default subtitle Menu Language. If the DVD film does not support that language then it will not be used.

Parental Ctrl

Press to select Parental Ctrl and use the arrows to move to the desired setting from the lowest level (1 kid) to the highest level (8 Adult). To cancel this function, select off option.

Screen Saver

Set to on for a screensaver to appear on the screen hen no action has been made on the player.

Angle Mark

Switch on for Angle encoded DVD's or off.

Playing Back a Kodak Picture CD/JPEG/AUDIO

1. Load your Kodak Picture CD or JPEG disc.

When a KODAK Picture CD is loaded, playback will start automatically.

2. Select a folder or a picture/track contained on the JPEG, a menu will appear on the screen. Press UP or DOWN to select a folder, and press ENTER to view folder contents.

3. Select playback mode.

You can use the button REPEAT to select one playback mode, repeat one (continually repeat the current picture/track) or all (repeat all pictures).

Press UP or DOWN to choose the picture or song you want to enjoy.

4. Start playback

Press PLAY to playback the pictures or songs.

5. Use the STOP or MENU button to view the contents

When JPEG CD is played, the STOP or MENU is used to display JPEG folders and the corresponding files.

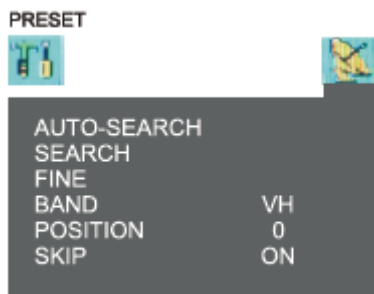

Scanning in Analogue Television

ATV: First press the MODE button on either the DVD or remote control. Move the up/down button to select "ATV" and press "ok" to select.

Auto Search

In order to now perform a search for your analogue press the "MENU" button twice to bring up the following menu options. Use the arrow buttons to move to Auto-Search and then press the arrow pointing right to start the scan. The DVD will now find the strongest signals and store them on your player.



BAND

If you find that your not picking up any channels you could also try changing the "band" by pressing left and right and then try Auto Searching again.

FINE

This options allows you to manual skip through the frequency range, press left or right to skip through the available range.

SKIP

If you have skip set to on the scan will ignore the weaker channels and will not store them.

POSITION

This is an indication of the channel position scanned in.

Scanning in DVB Freeview Channels

Before you can start a scan you need to first make sure you're in the DVB mode. To do this press the "mode" button and then use the arrow keys to move to "DVB" and press ok.

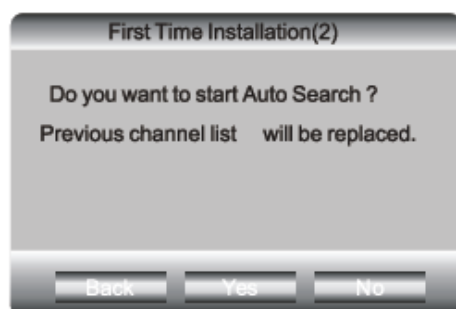
Once you have entered the DVB mode, the screen will display First Time Installation. It will guide you through the process. Move the tab to "YES" and press ok to begin.



Now input your regional information, including the country, OSD language and Time zone and move down to Next, the player will now automatically scan channels through the information provided.



If prompted do you want to erase the previous channels select "Yes", the system will now automatically scan for the channels available in your freeview catchment area.

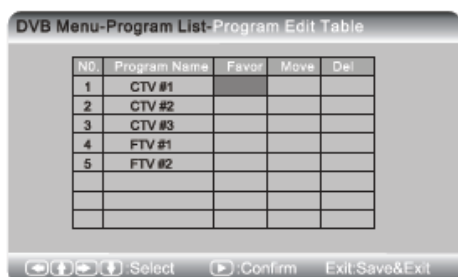
DVB Setup and Menu

In the DVB mode press the SETUP button to bring up the main menu. Now move to "DVB menu" and press ok to enter.



TV Program

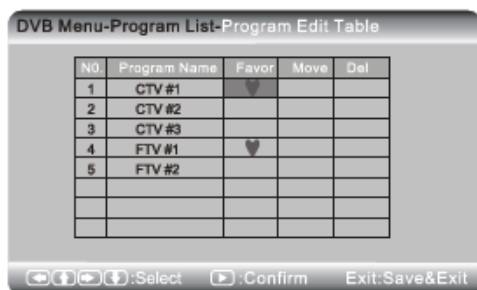
This option allows you to edit the program list and set programs into three types, including Favorite program, Move the program and Delete. All programs available to watch will be on the list. Press the setup button to save and exit.



Favor

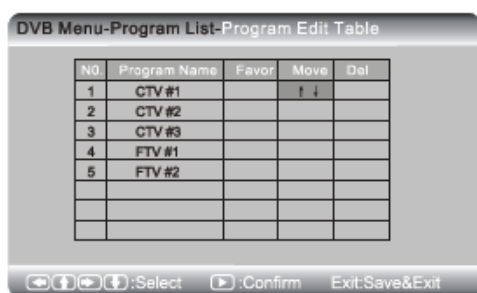
You can edit more than one program as a favorite channel using this option. Use the arrows to move to selected channel and press the ok button to select, once a program is chosen, a mark will appear in the favor box. To remove the cursor from the favor list, press the ok button in the favor box of that program. Press the setup button to save and exit.

DVB Setup and Menu



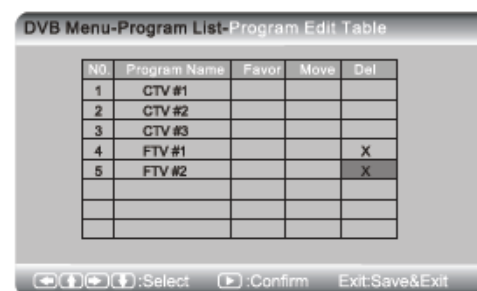
Move

This option allows you to move the selected channel from one position to another, in order to do this first move to the channel you want to move and press ok, two arrows will appear in the "move" box. Now press up or down to move to the position where you would like the channel to be moved to and press ok to confirm the move. Press the setup button to save and exit.



Del

This allows you to delete a single or all of the channels currently scanned in. To delete one program, Press the ok button on the Delete box of the selected channel (an "X" will appear in the "Del" box). Press the setup button to save and exit.



Notes: User can use Program Search option to recover the deleted programs.

Music Program

This option is identical to the TV program sort on page 15.

Sort

You can sort channels on the list according to channel name, service ID or channel number. Simply move to the selected option and press ok. Press setup to save and exit.



Program Search

Automatic Search

If you want to do another scan for any reason you can select Automatic Scan. Press ok to select and again on whether you want to perform a scan. If it asks that you want to erase your current stations then again select yes.

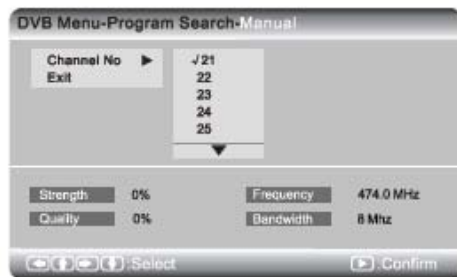

The channels from manual search will be added to the list, but the unit will not return directly to the playing status at this moment.



Parental control



Channel Lock

Channel lock allows you to set the DVD into the parental lock mode, this means that if you do have any Parental settings setup they will become activated, set to no to switch this off.

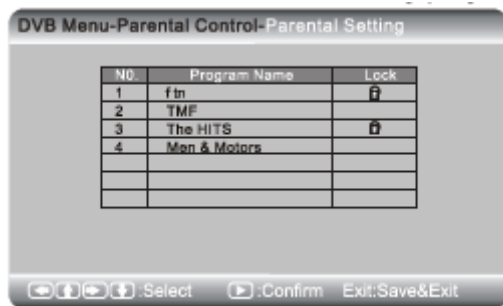

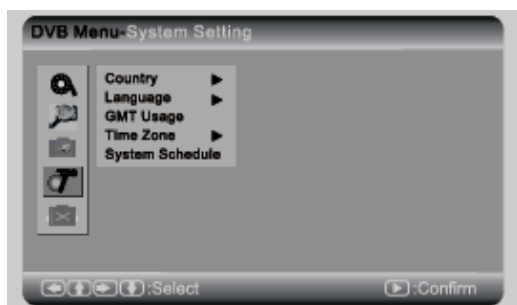

Parental Setting

Parental setting allows you to lock certain channels preventing them from being viewed unless a password is inputted. Simply press ok on the desired channel you wish to lock and a padlock sign will show up, to unlock press ok again. Note if channel lock (page 18) is not on then this will not activate. If at any time a prompt for a password appears enter 8888.



System Setting



Country

Select this option to set the country for the scan.

Language

Three options are available 1st Audio, 2nd Audio and Subtitle.

1st/2nd Audio

You can choose the audio language from audio 1st or audio 2nd this option only works when the channel provides Audio. Otherwise, the preset language of that channel will be automatically chosen.

Select the subtitle language from the list available. The subtitle language will only appear to the set language of the channel signal.

GMT Usage

Use this option to select the current GMT time.

Time Zone

Select this option to set the time zone where the DVB system is being used to scan.

Basic Operation

Adjust Channel

- Press CH-/CH+ to turn to previous/next channels or press the number buttons on the remote control.
- While watching a program, press ok to bring up the channel list, the program list will be shown on the screen. You can press up and down to move to another channel and press ok to change.
- While watching a program, press the GUIDE button, the GUIDE MENU will be displayed. showing a thumbnail of the channels available, use the arrows to move to a channel and press ok to change.

Mute

Press the "mute" button to switch to mute mode, the mute sign will appear on the screen. Press it again, the unit will return to normal sound.

Program Information

In DVB playing status, Press DISPLAY button, the detail information of the program will be displayed on the screen.

Sleeping Mode

Press sleep button to set a time to turn the unit off. The time can be set from 15 min, 30 min, 60 min and 120 min. At the first time of selecting Sleep, the preset time will appear, Press it repeatedly, the time will be prolonged. To cancel the function, press the button repeatedly until Sleep Off appears.

Audio

Press audio button to choose audio output port (Audio 1 or Audio 2). There are three audio modes: LL, RR and LR.

Choosing Subtitles

Press the subtitle button to choose the subtitle language.

DVB Basic Operation

EPG Page

Press the EPG button to display the current channel information and all other available channels. Use the arrow buttons to navigate through the installed programs.

USB/SD Operation

If you wish to use a USB or SD first make sure your using the correct file types.

Movies – AVI/MPEG

Music – MP3

Images – JPEG

Once you have placed a file onto the USB/SD device insert into the corresponding port located at the back of the DVD player. Now press the “mode” button and move to either USB or SD and press the arrow pointing right to change to that mode. The unit will automatically play the first file on the storage device, if you wish to change the file simply press the “menu” button which will then display the contents of the device. Navigate with the arrow buttons and press ok to play.

AV Connection

You can also connect your DVD player to a larger screen by using the AV connection wire (supplied) Simply connect the jack end into the AV out on the side of the player and the Red/White and Yellow to the AV in on your TV. Press the “mode” button and move to AV then press the arrow pointing right to select this mode. Also make sure that your TV is set to the AV mode as well.
