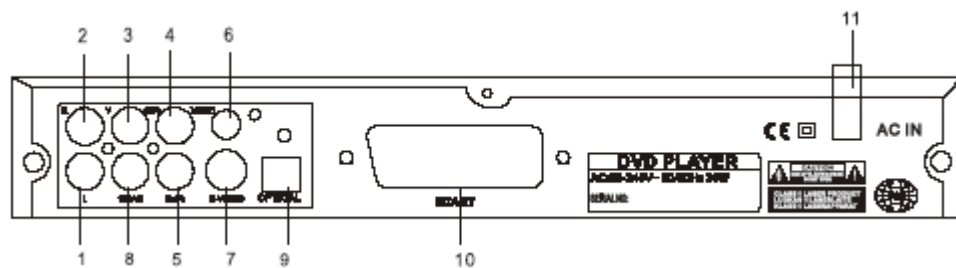

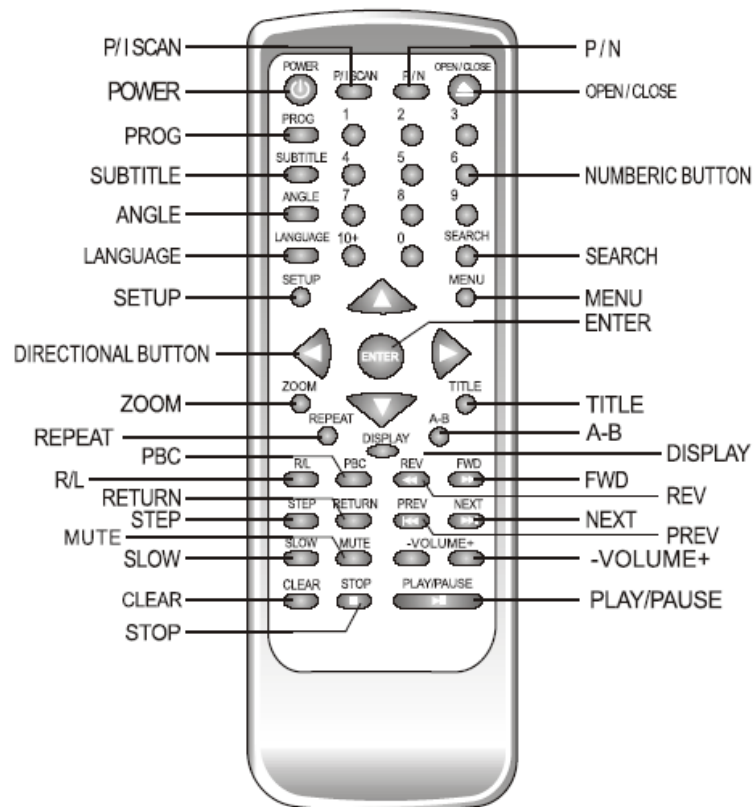

Remote control and panel button functions

Power

Turn on/off the DVD player

Display

Displays the DVD info, keep pressing for additional DVD info

Open/Close

Open or Close the DVD tray

Language

Select your desired language for DVD's which have more than one language encoded.

Angle

Press ANGLE to select your desired angle when playing DVD's with multi angle encoded into it.

Mute

Mute the sound during playback

Search

Press to display CH, Chapter/Chapter, Total Current running time. In order to select a chapter and or time of the chapter simply use the arrows left or right on the remote and then input the numbers using your keypad on the remote. Once selected press enter to confirm.

Zoom

Press to Zoom, keep pressing to increase the zoom enlargement. To turn off the zoom keep pressing until off is displayed.

Menu

Press Menu to return to the main DVD menu.

Number Keys

Press for numbered selections

Title

Directional Buttons

Directional buttons are used for navigating through menu options

Enter

Used to confirm your selection

Setup

Press SETUP to get into the DVD setup

PBC

This function is only available for Video-CD version 2.0 or higher. The PBC function may differ with each disc. With PBC ON, you can select items in the menu list using the PREVIOUS/NEXT keys. When PBC is OFF, you cannot select items in the menu list but you can use the numeral keys directly or the PREVIOUS and NEXT keys

Remote control and panel button functions

Volume +/-

Increase or decrease the volume

R/L

Switch the audio output. When playing a SVCD and VCD, press R/L to change channels as follows: MONO R, AUTO L, and AUTO R.

When playing a CD switch the output audio to MONO L, MOMO R and STEREO

Return

Press to return to the main menu of the DVD

A-B repeat

Press A-B once to select the A repeat point then again to select point B, the DVD will then only play between the two points selected. To cancel the A-B repeat press it one more time.

Repeat 1/All

This option will run through the available disc repeat options

Step

Press to play the film frame by frame, keep pressing to move to the next frame. To cancel press play.

Next and Previous

In order to skip forward or back a chapter press the Prev or Next button on the Remote

Rev and Fwd

Rev rewinds the DVD and Fwd fast forwards the DVD

Stop

Press STOP to stop the DVD playing.

Pause

Pauses playback, press play to resume

Play

Confirm your selection or playback

P/I Scan

Changes the current DVD input mode from TV/RGB, PSCAN YPBPR and SVIDEO

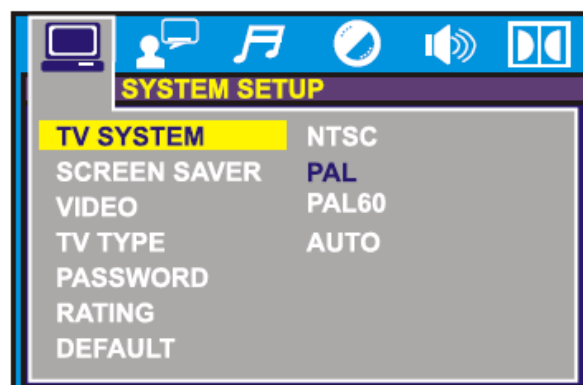
Basic Operation

Press SETUP ON the remote control to bring up the DVD setup page, use the directional buttons to navigate to the desired option.

SYSTEM SETUP

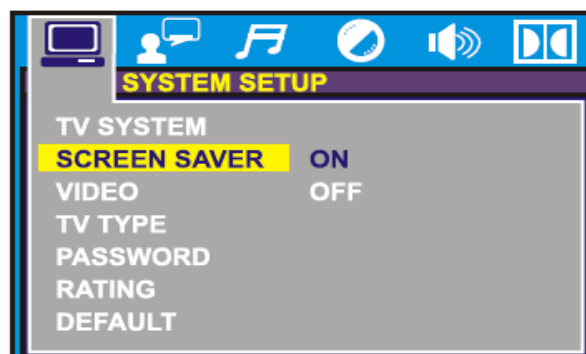
Press SETUP and select system setup page.

TV SYSTEM: Use up/down arrow buttons to select the TV system from either NTSC/PAL/PAL60 or AUTO.



SCREEN SAVER

Use up/down arrow buttons to select the status OFF/ON for the screen saver. When in the ON position and the unit has been idle for more than 60 seconds a screen saver will appear to protect the screen.

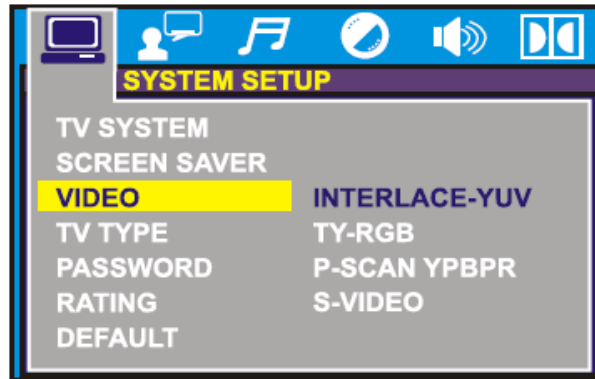

There are four video outputs to choose from Interlace-YUV, YV-RGB, P-scan YPBPR and S-Video.



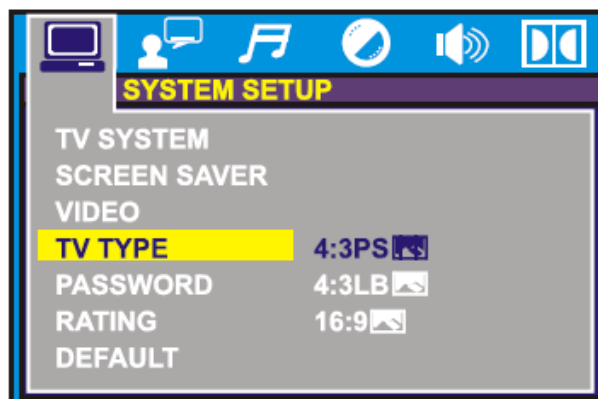
TV TYPE:

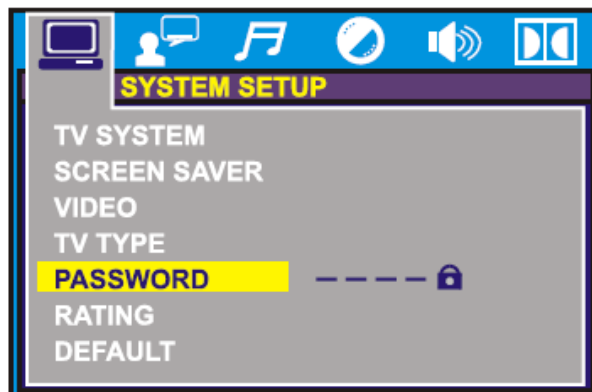

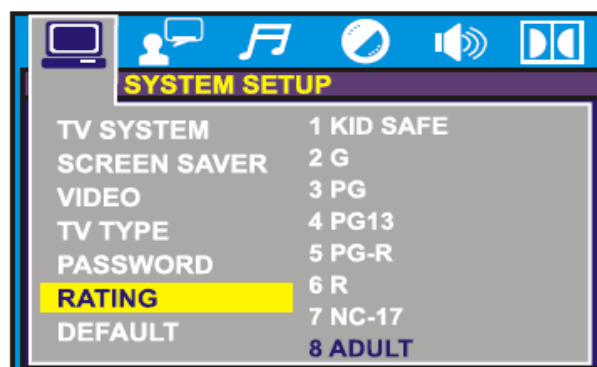
Password:

The default password is 0000, this cannot be changed. Enter 0000 and press enter in order to unlock the player to allow you to change the rating setting shown below. Repeat to lock.



Rating setting:

Once you have unlocked the password padlock you can change the rating setting to make sure that certain films are not viewed by the younger audience. However this will only work on DVD's which have this encoded into it. Simply move to the required age limit and press enter, once finished lock the password again.

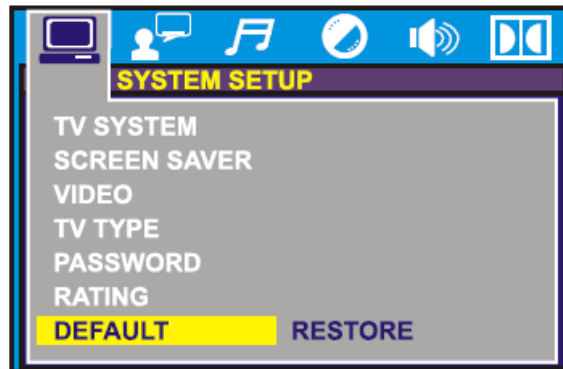

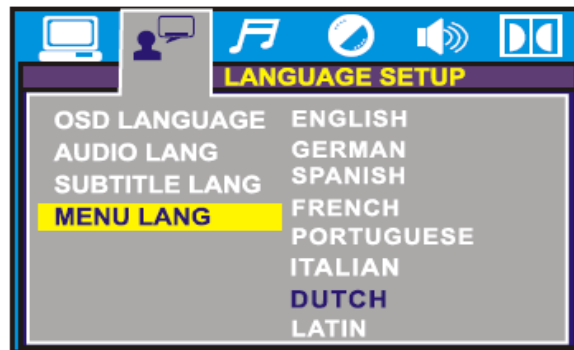

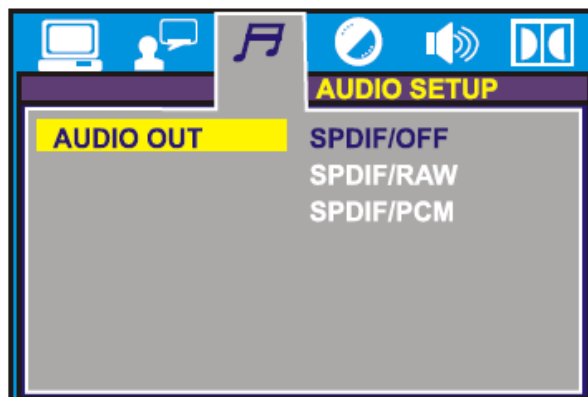
Use to alter the current Menu language.

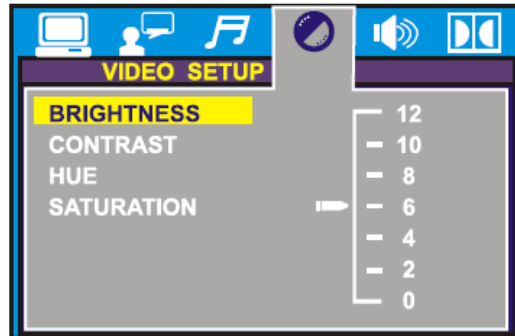

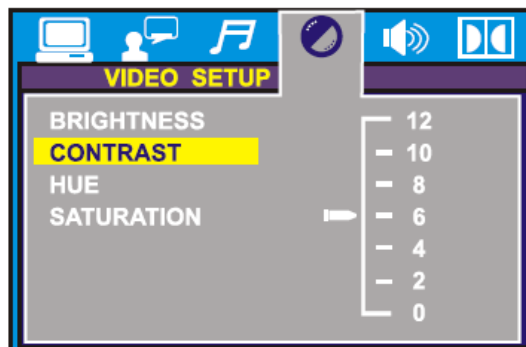

Video Setup

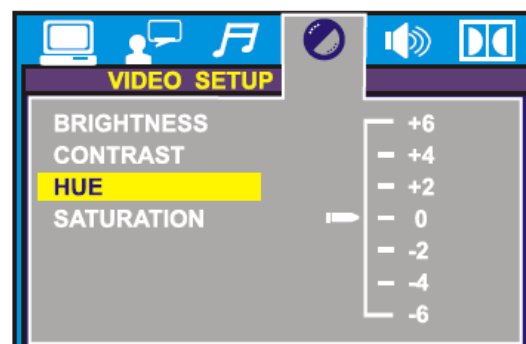
Brightness: Use the right arrow to move onto the brightness bar and then the up and down arrow on your remote to adjust the brightness



Contrast: Use the right arrow to move onto the contrast bar and then the up and down arrow on your remote to adjust the contrast

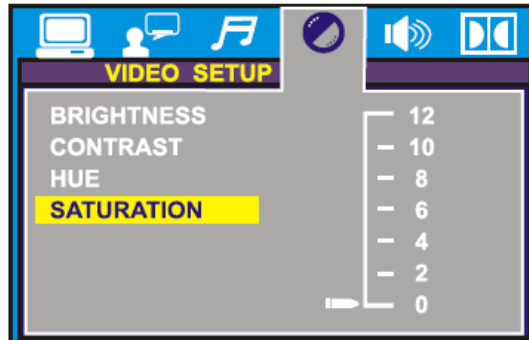


Hue: Use the right arrow to move onto the HUE bar and then the up and down arrow on your remote to adjust the HUE

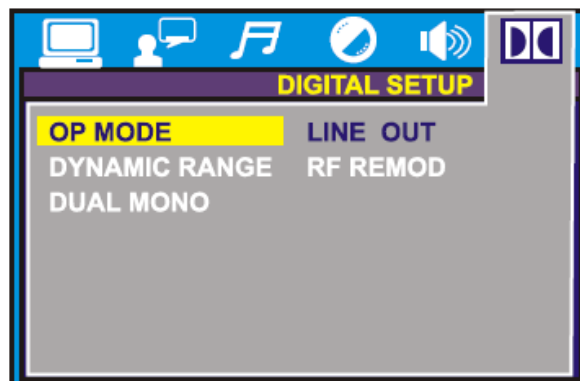

OP Mode:

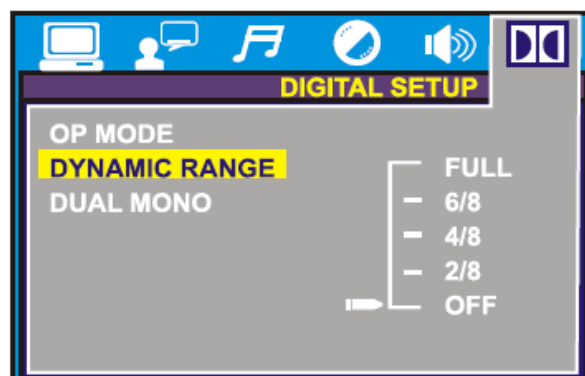
Line out – This setting is generally used for when your connecting to a amplifier.

RF Remod – This setting is for when connecting to a TV.



Dynamic Range:

If you are connecting to an amplifier and your OP mode is set to Line out you can also adjust the dynamic range to increase or decrease the sound compression. Press the right arrow then the up and down to adjust.

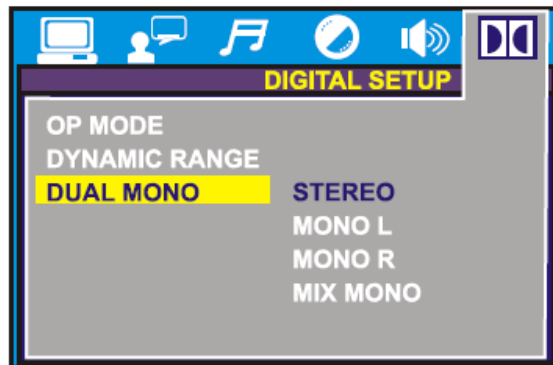

Dual Mono:

You can change the audio output to one of the following Stereo, Mono L, Mono R and Mix Mono using the directional buttons on your remote.



Viewing pictures

You can also view pictures from a picture disk.

- 1 - First make sure that the pictures you have on your disk are in JPEG format only, no other format will work.
- 2 - Place the disk into the DVD player and await for the files to display in a name display.
- 3 - Use the directional buttons on the remote to move to your desired picture and press enter to view.
- 4 - You can also zoom in by pressing the zoom button on the remote.

Trouble Shooting

Symptoms	Possible Cause and Remedies
No power	Make sure the plug is in and switched on at the mains. Make sure that you have pressed in the power button on the player
No playback	Check the power is on Check the disc is in the correct way Check for scratches on the disc and clean with a soft dry cloth The region of the disc may not be compatible The format of the disc may not be compatible
No Video	Check all your connections Make sure your TV is in the correct receiving mode i.e scart or AV
Picture distorted	The disc maybe damaged or over scratched, try a new disc Try connecting the DVD directly to then TV with no other connections involved
